



Please be informed that,

pursuant to art. 13 and art. 14 of the GDPR no. 2016/679 (hereafter, "GDPR"):

1. The Data Controller is ifm ecolink Sp. z o.o. whose registered office is Opole (45-805 Opole) on Północna 6 street, (KRS: 0000393934, NIP: 6342793521, REGON: 242632586) („the Data Controller”)
2. The Data Controller has also appointed a Data Protection Officer ("DPO") – Mrs. Bożenę Krawczuk, whom you may contact directly to exercise your rights and to receive any information concerning the processing of your personal data and/or concerning this Notice, by writing to: ecolink.iod@ifm.com
3. Your personal data will be processed in order to:
 - A/ processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party based on art. 6 (1)(b);
 - B/ processing is necessary to comply with the law e.g. financial and accounting settlement based on art. 6(1)(c);
 - C/ to seek redress based on art. 6(1)(f)
 - D/ in marketing purpose based on art. 6(1)(f)
 - E/ for statistical and analytical purposes aimed at testing the sales potential based on the legal basis of art. 6(1)(f)
 - F/ handling complaints based on art. 6(1)(f)
 - G/ for the purposes of contract performance and business relationships that occur between the employer who is our client or contractor based on the legal basis of art. 6(1)(f)
4. Your personal data will be communicated and processed by third parties belonging to the following categories:

tax offices, banks, carriers, Poczta Polska SA, courier companies, law firms, the National Tax Administration, customs offices, translators, statutory auditors, audit companies, security company, companies servicing IT systems and devices, company that operates telephone exchanges, mother company - ifm electronic gmbh
5. Your personal data will not be transferred to third parties outside the European Union and will not be disseminated.
6. Your personal data will be processed for a period of time determined by the law, included rights related to seek redress.



7. In relation to the processing data, as a data subject you can exercise the rights of: obtain access to your personal data, rectification that data, erasure, restriction of processing, receive a data copy, right to object for points C, D, F, G
8. Providing your personal data is voluntary, but necessary to perform the contract or to take action before the conclusion of the contract.
9. You have the right to lodge a complaint to the President of the Urząd Ochrony Danych Osobowych (ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw), if you feel that the processing of your personal data violates the law.
10. Your data will not be automated processed, including in the form of profiling.
